Monthly Report on Significant Developments-June 2021

1. In pursuance “Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav celebration” and under “Aatma Nirbhar Bharat mission”, Asia's longest high-speed track at National Automotive Test Tracks (NATRAX), Indore was e-inaugurated on 29th June, 2021 at Pithampur near Indore in Madhya Pradesh by Shri Prakash Javadekar, Hon'ble Minister Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Ministry of Information and Broadcasting and Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises Government of India, in the August presence of Shri. Arjun Ram Meghwal, Hon'ble Minister of State for Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises Government of India, and Shri. Arun Goel, Secretary DHI. The High-speed track is one of the largest in world i.e 11.3 km with 4-lane and is used to carry out development and homologation tests for all kinds of vehicles. The large size of this track enables the OEM's to perform a wide variety of tests in one track itself like coast down tests, brake tests, constant speed fuel consumption test, speedometer calibration, noise & vibration measurement and mileage accumulation among others.

2. ICAT under NATRIP has successfully completed Electric Vehicle Test facility (Components) under FAME-II scheme of Department of Heavy Industry and this facility is for ready to use for industry.
